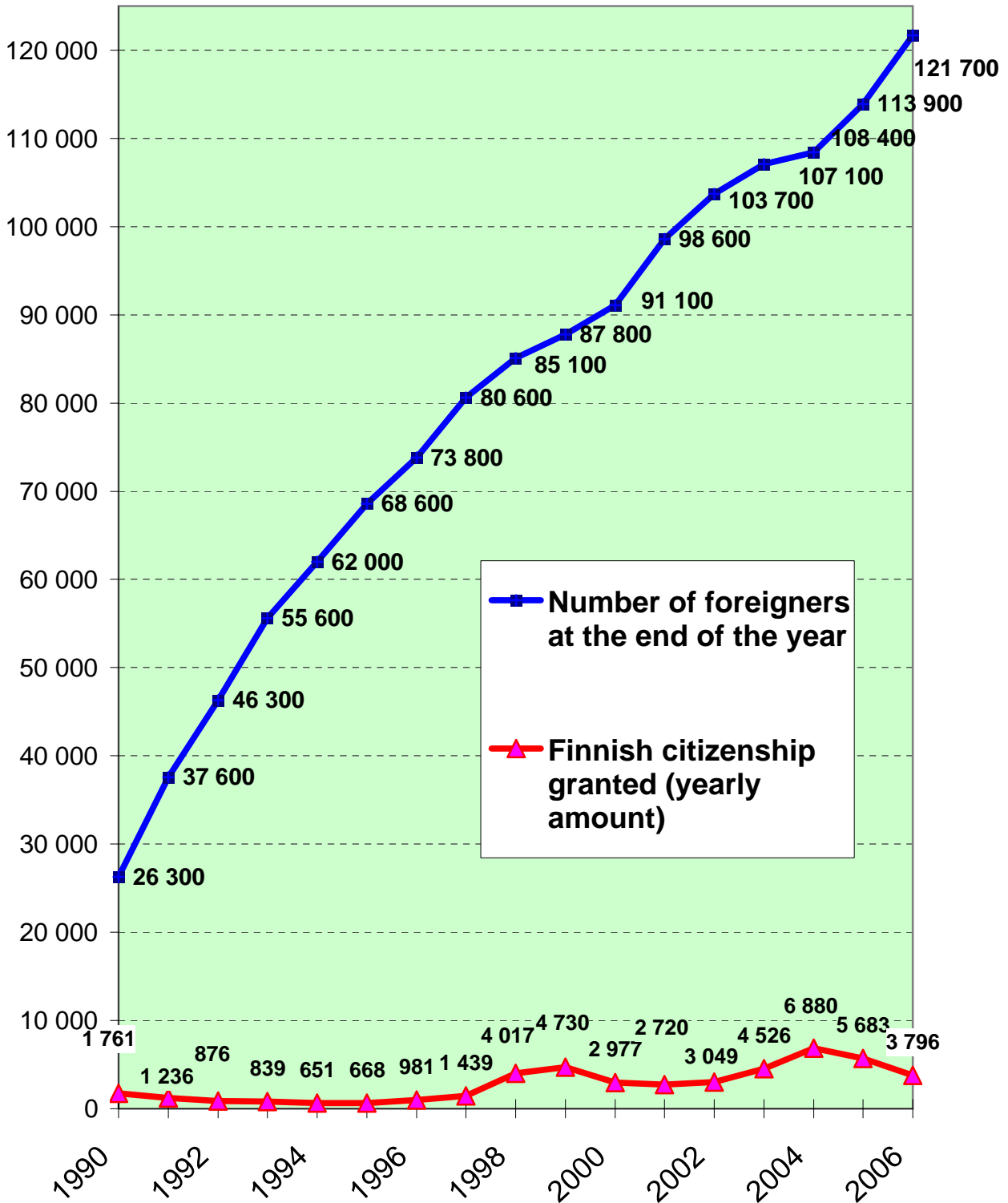

NUMBER OF FOREIGNERS IN FINLAND AND FINNISH CITIZENSHIP GRANTED ANNUALLY

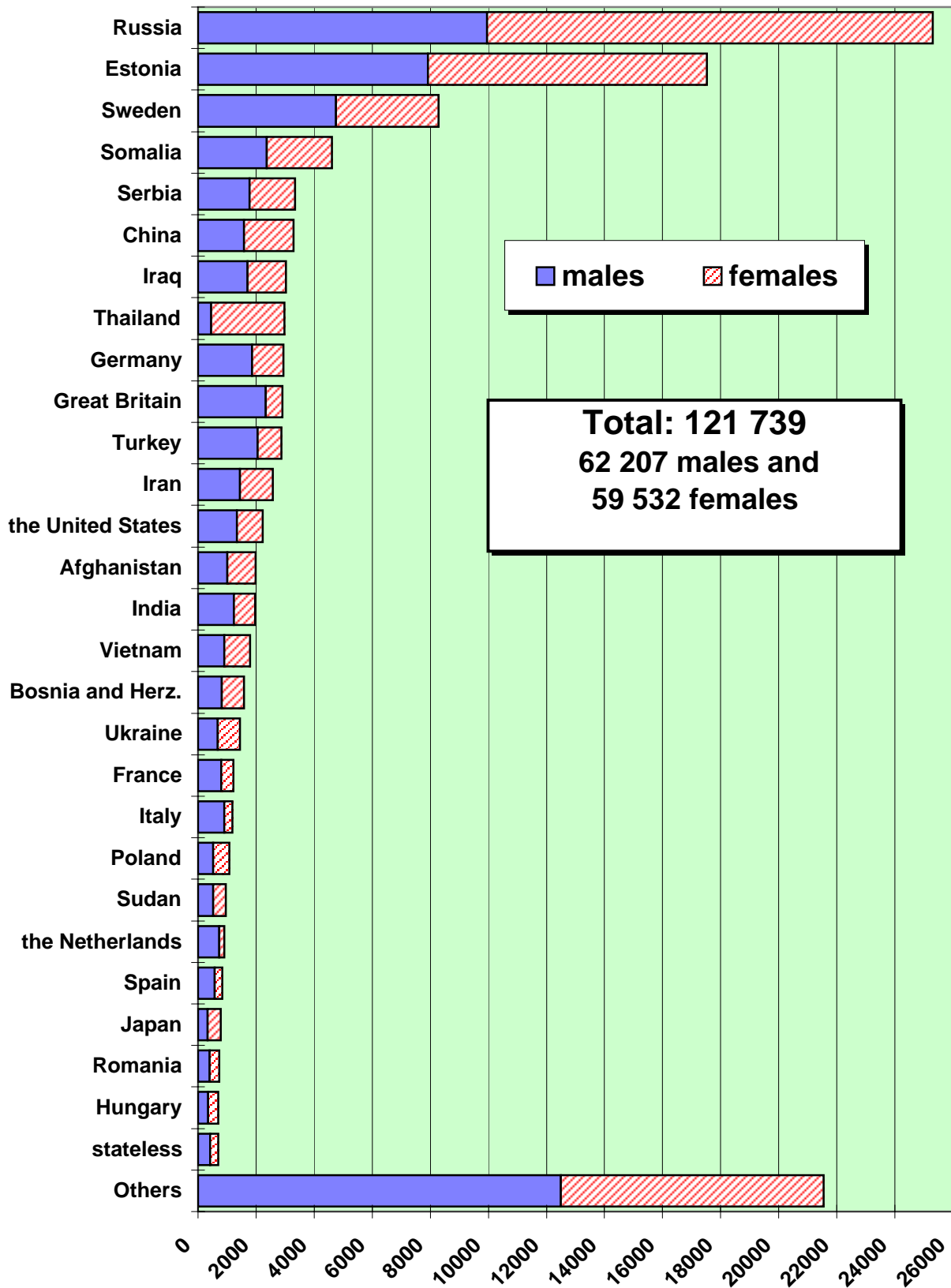

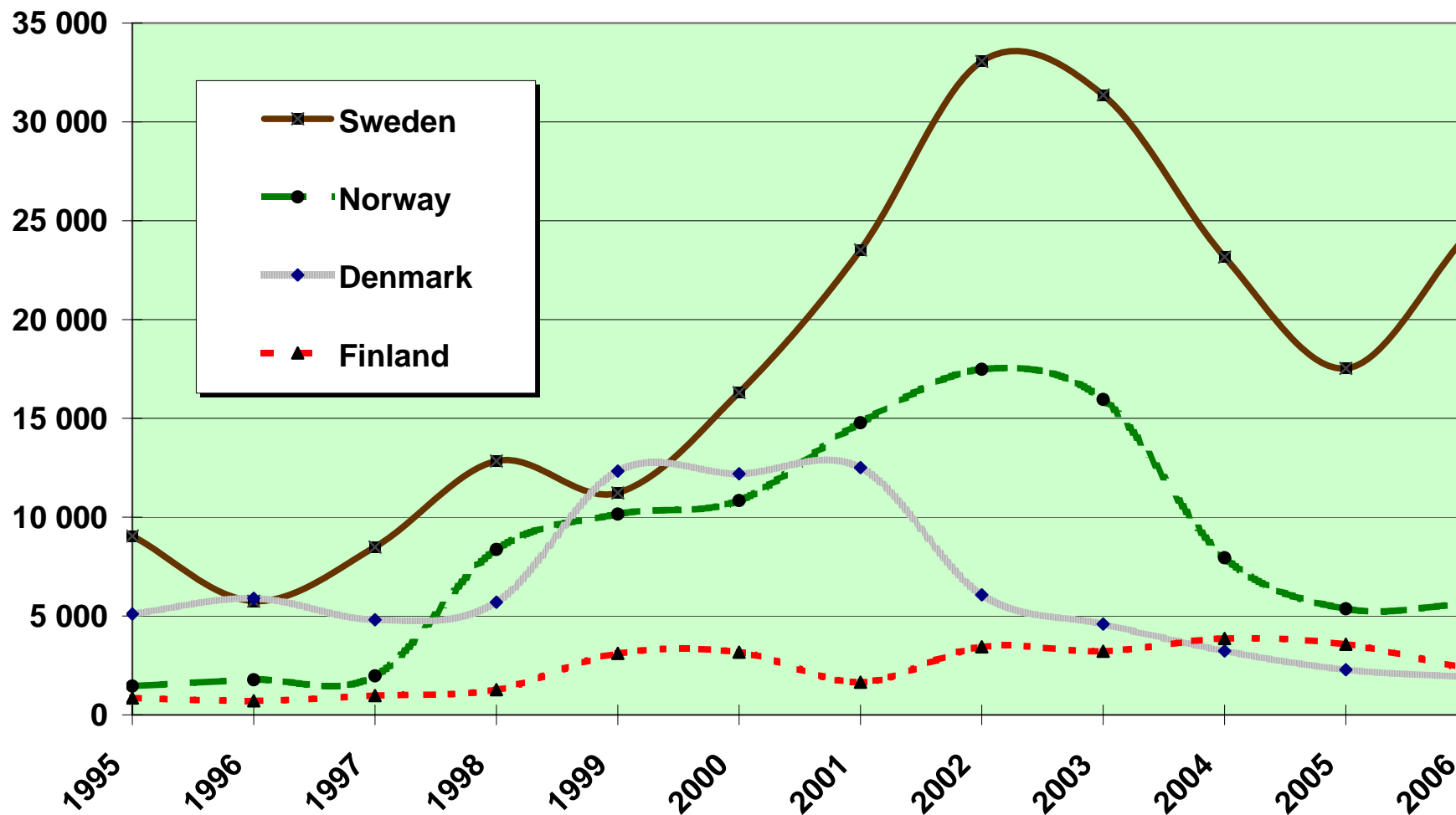

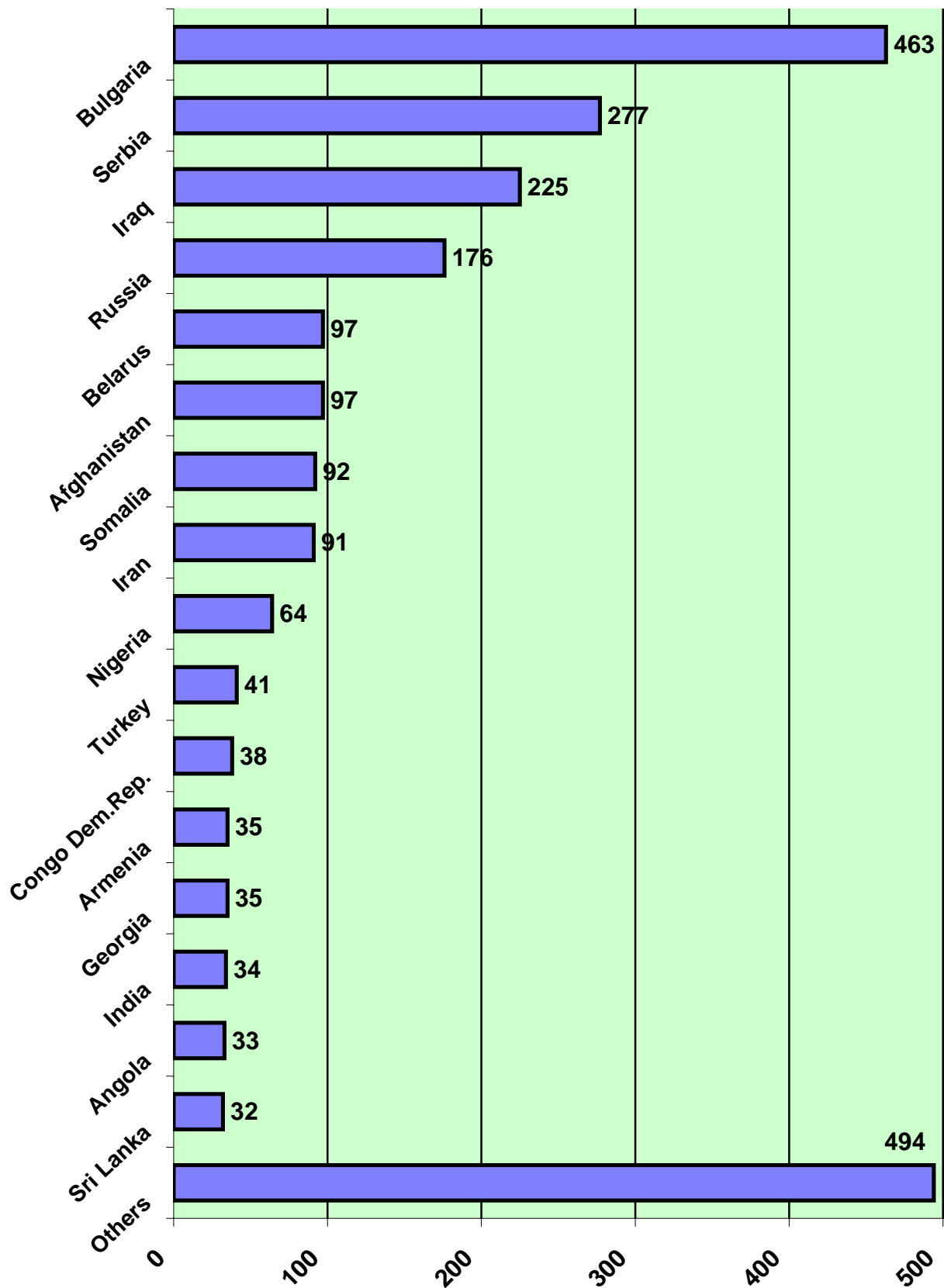
ASYLUM APPLICATIONS IN THE NORDIC COUNTRIES IN 1995-2006

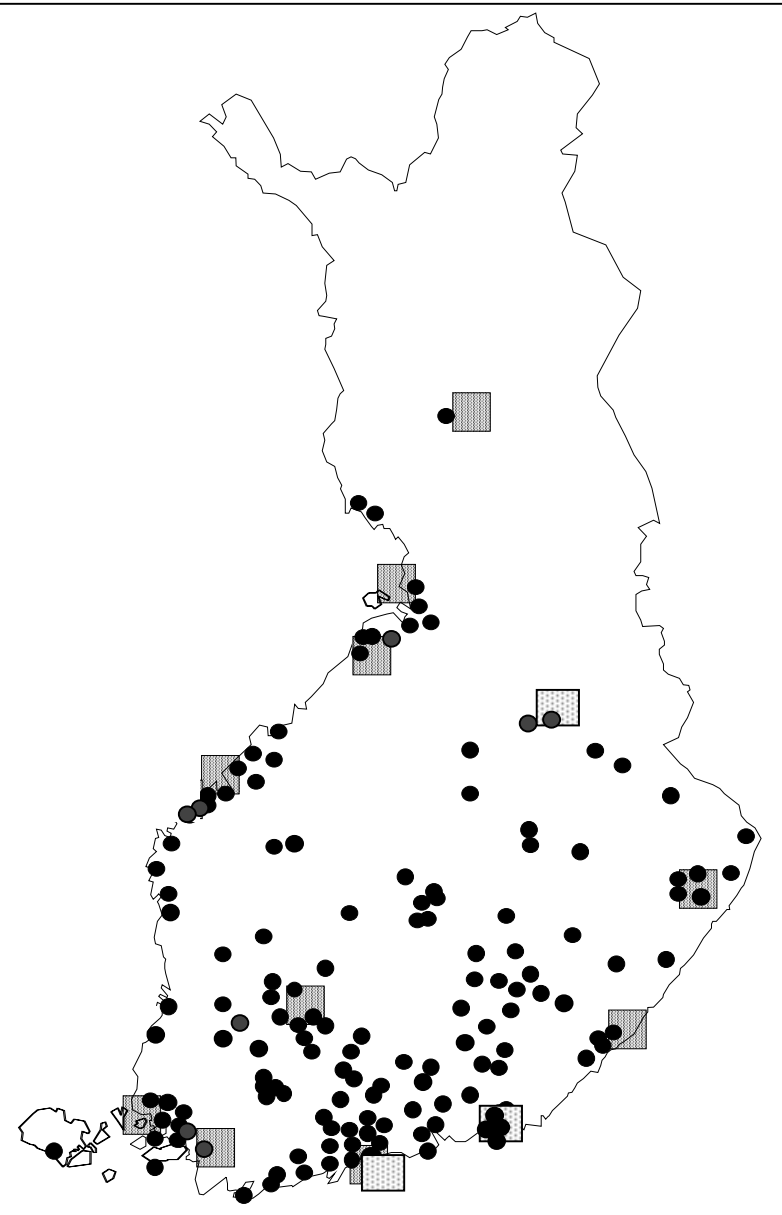

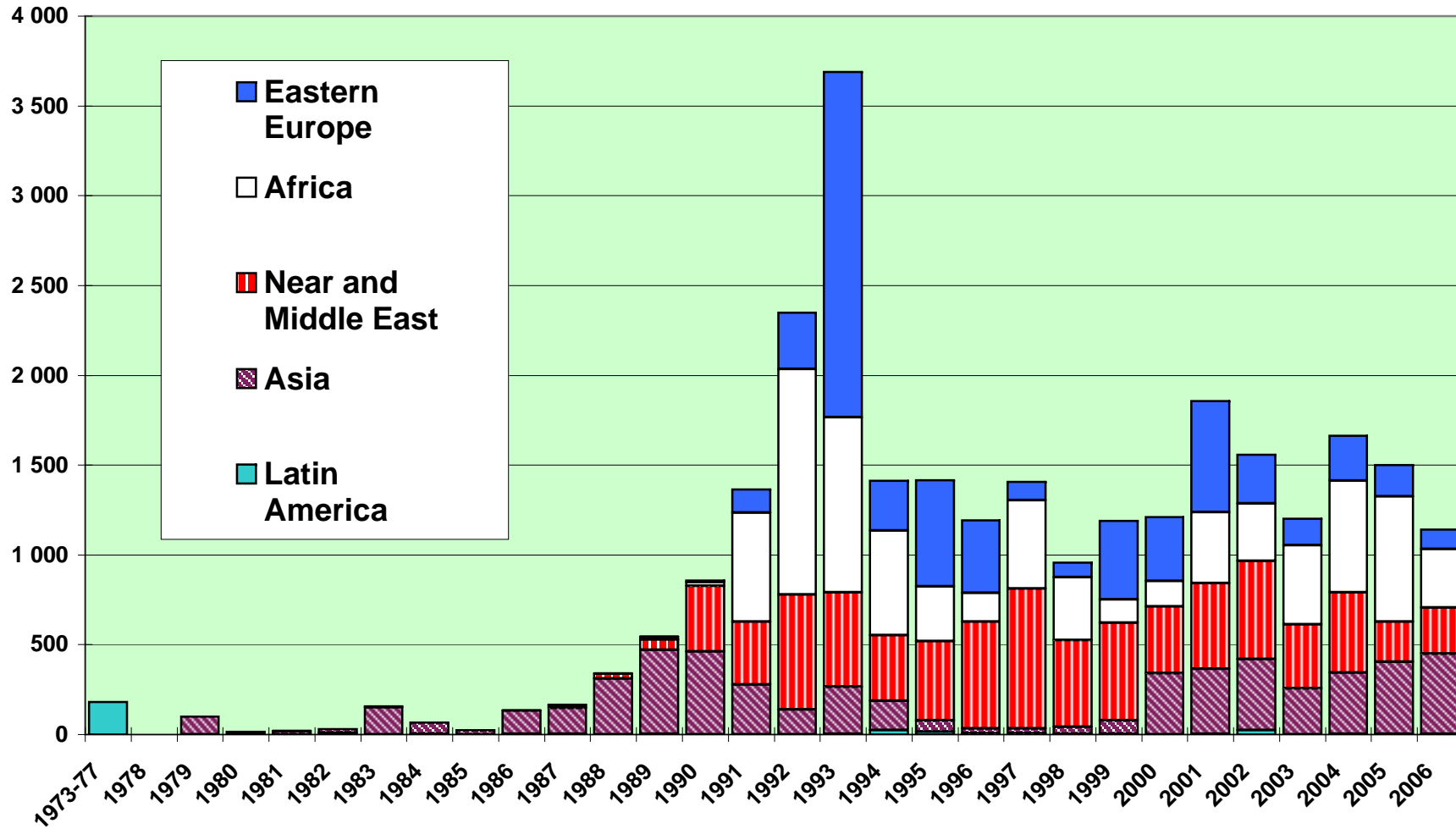

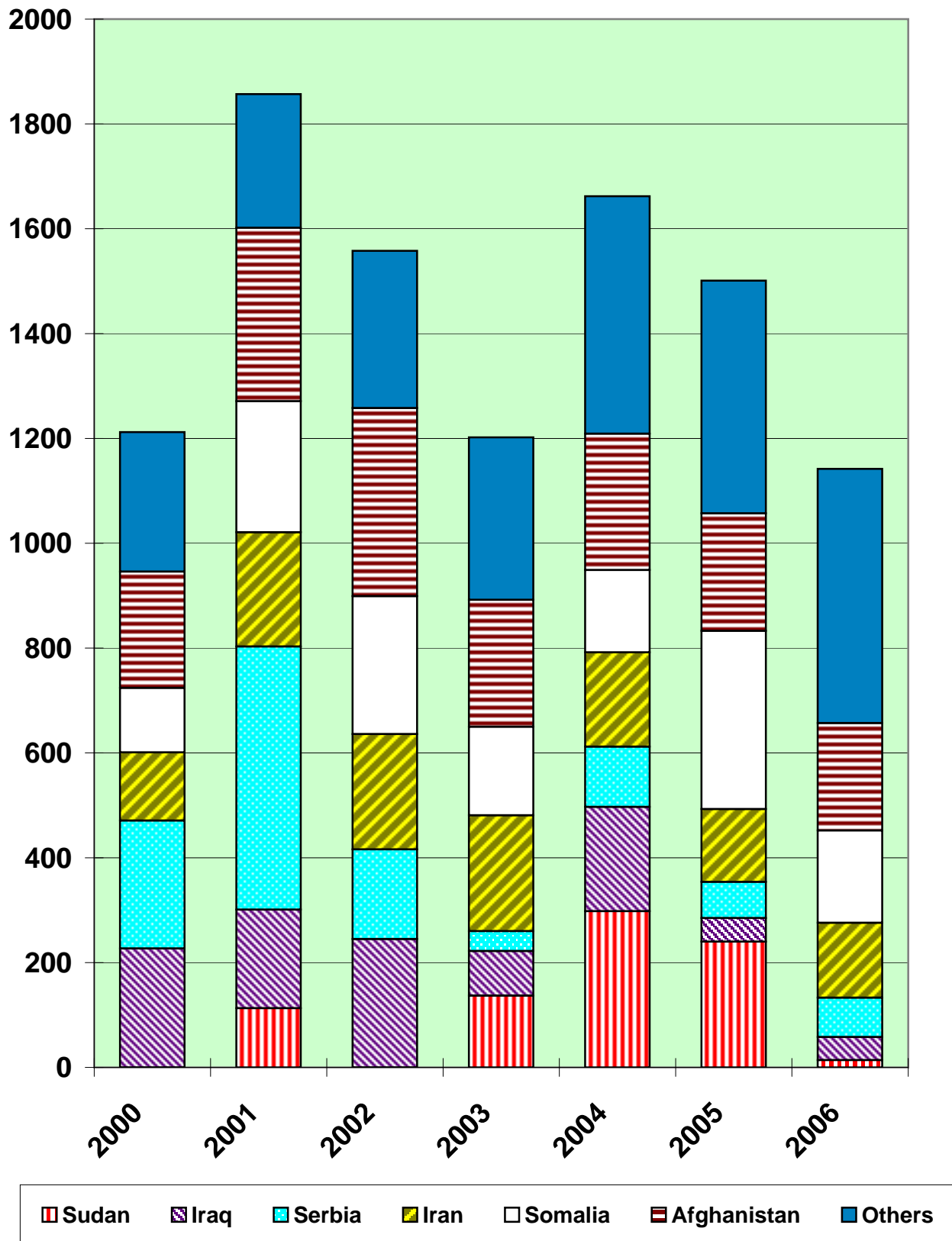

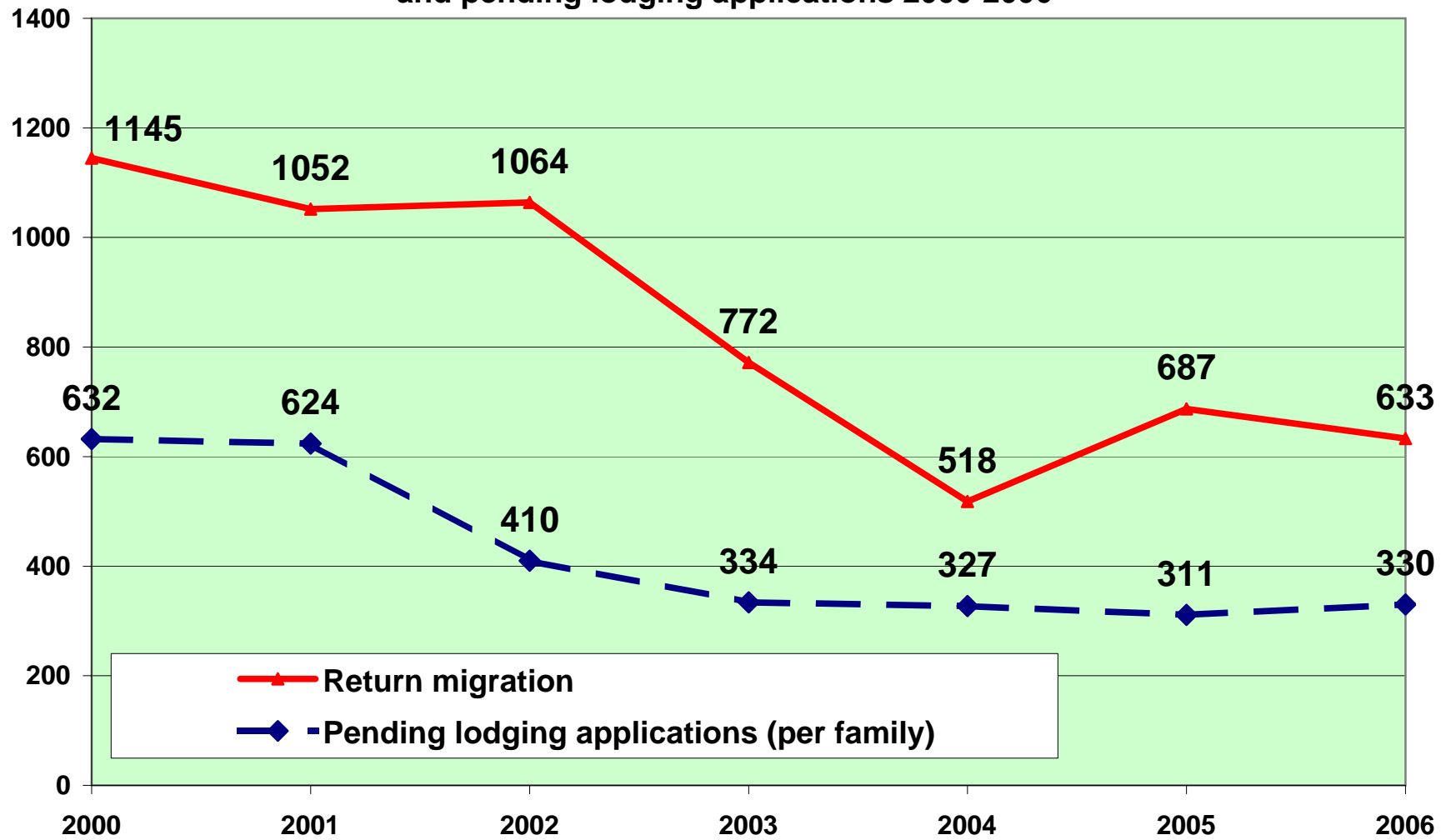
REFUGEES RECEIVED BY FINLAND 2000-2006

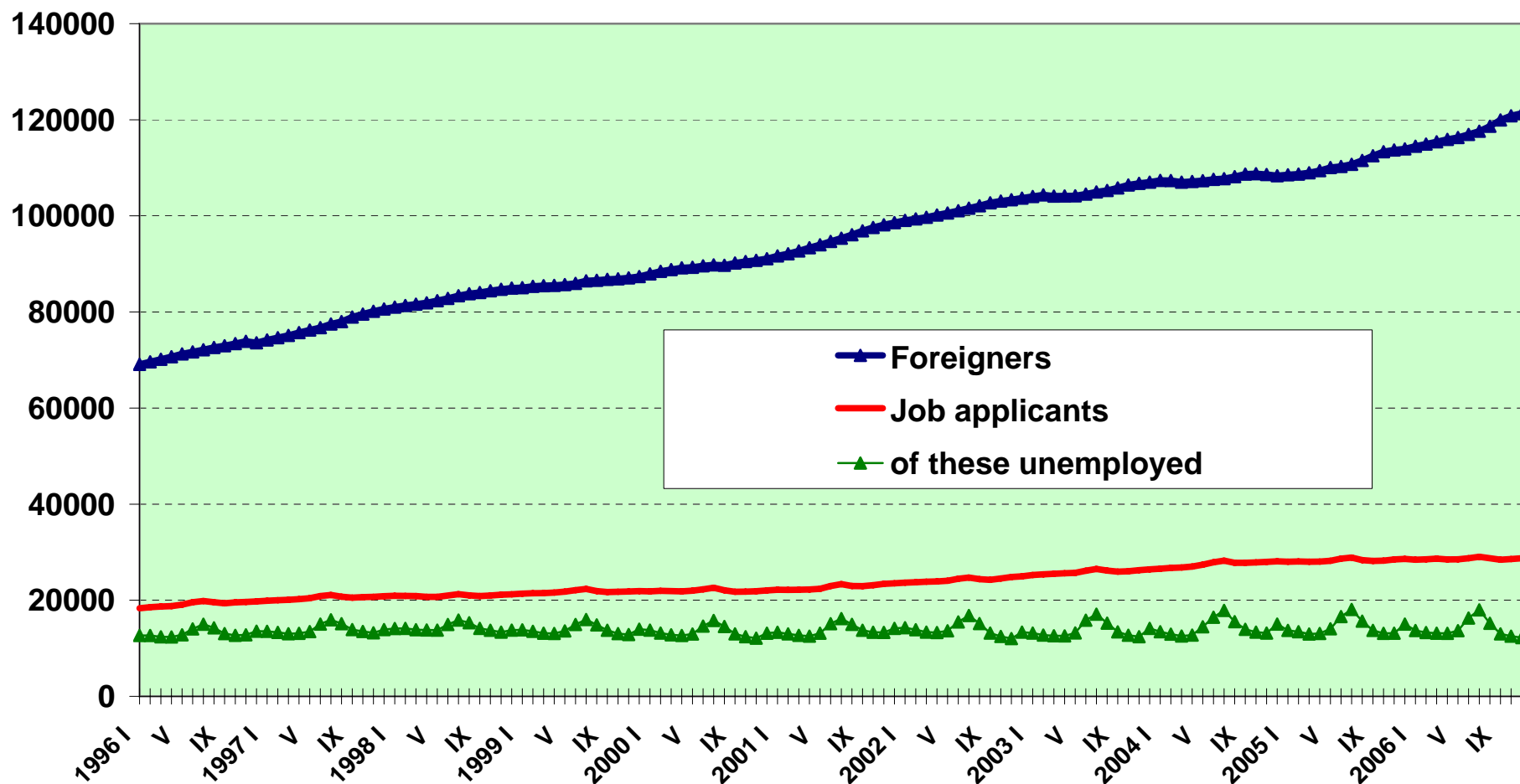
Return migration from the former Soviet Union and pending lodging applications 2000-2006

FOREIGN JOB APPLICANTS AND THE NUMBER OF FOREIGNERS monthly in 1996-2006

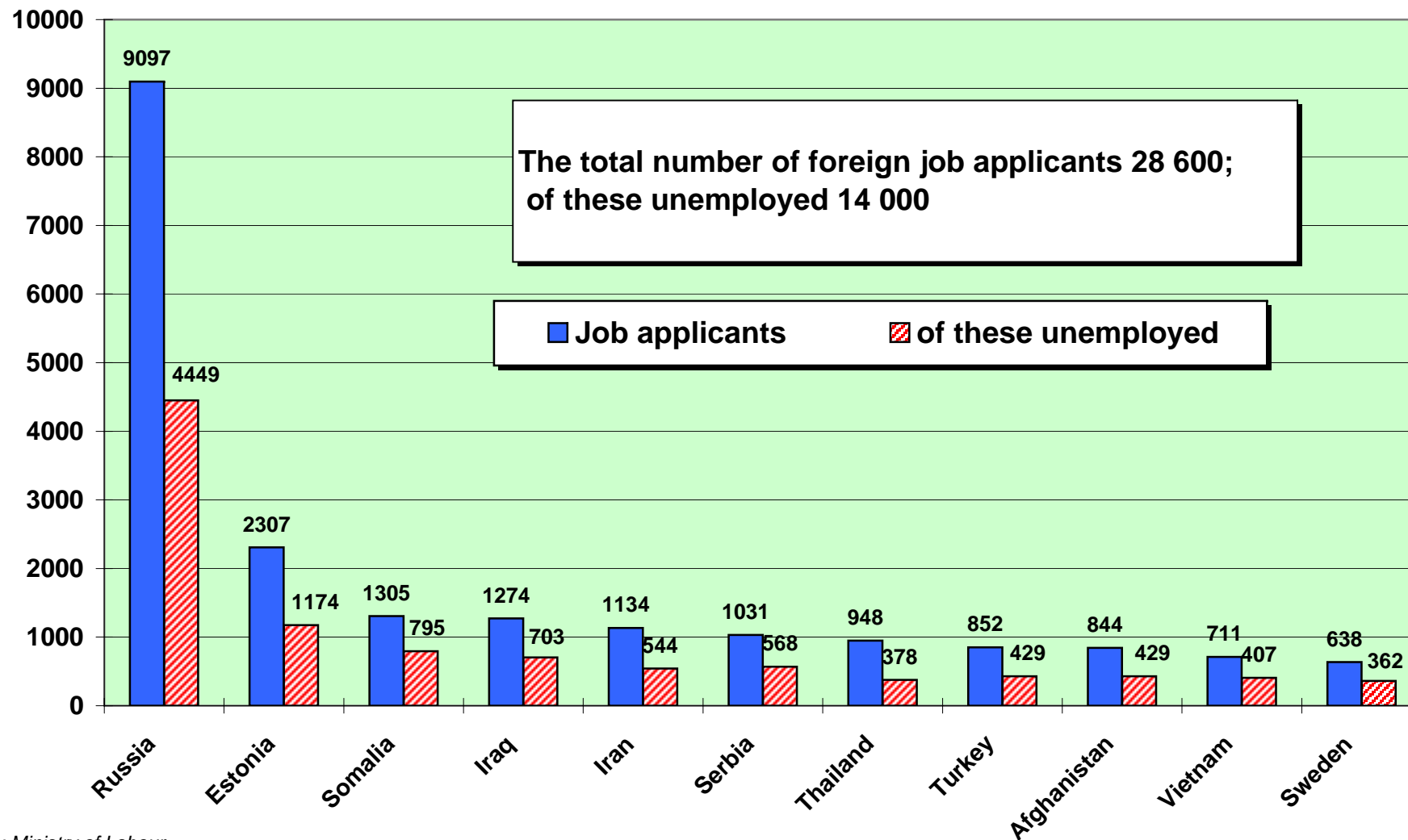

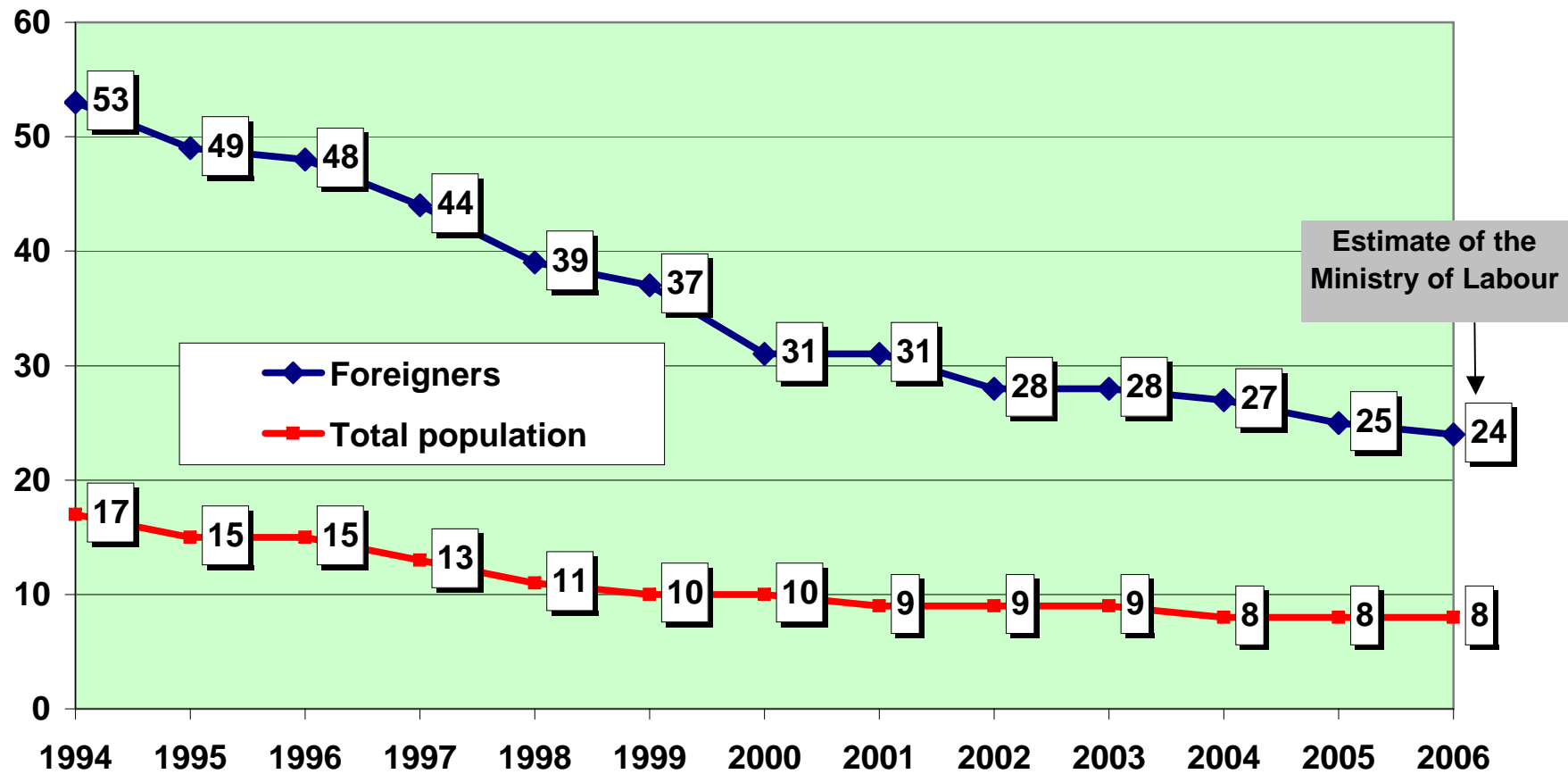

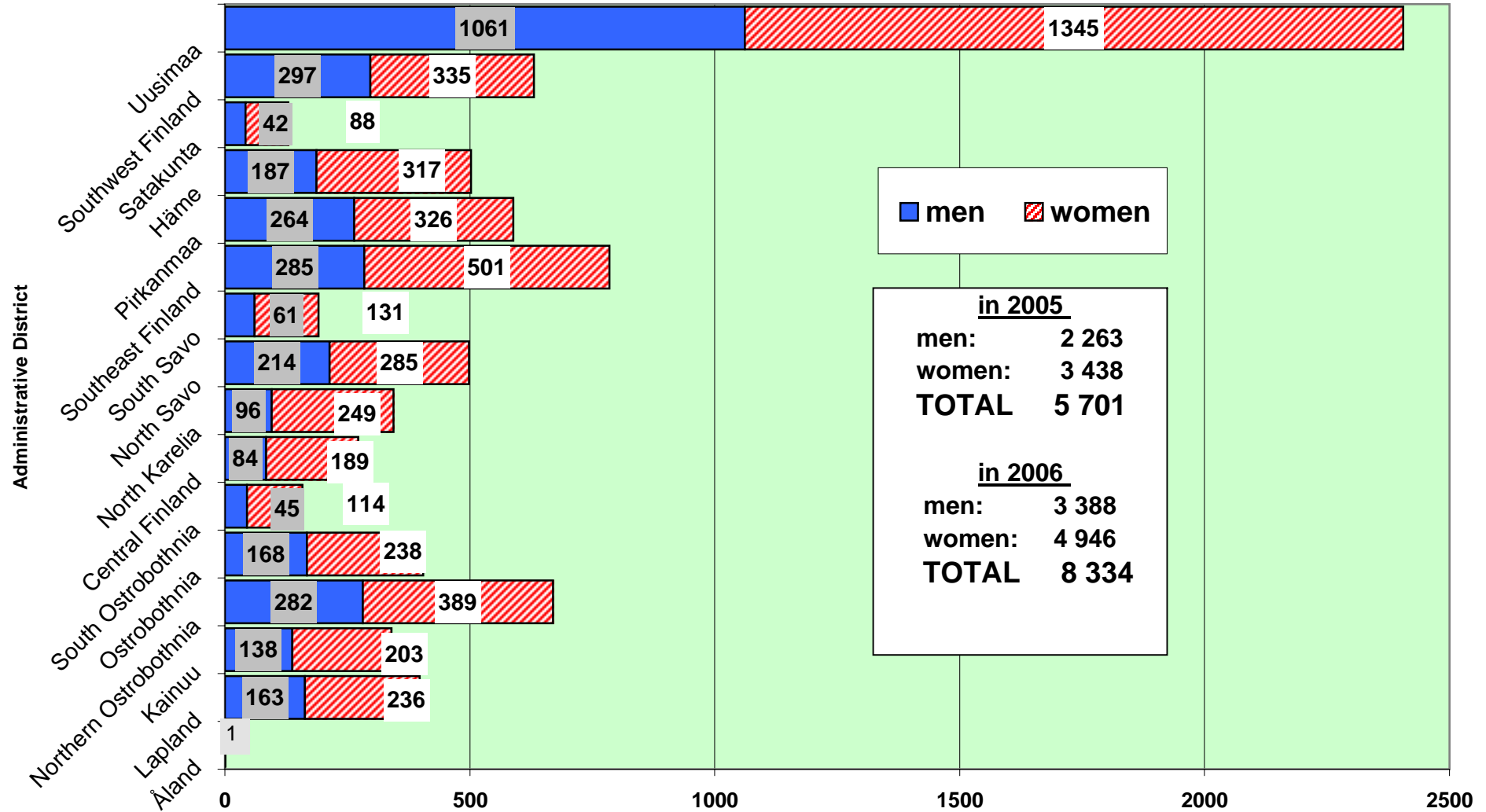
UNEMPLOYMENT RATES IN 1994-2006

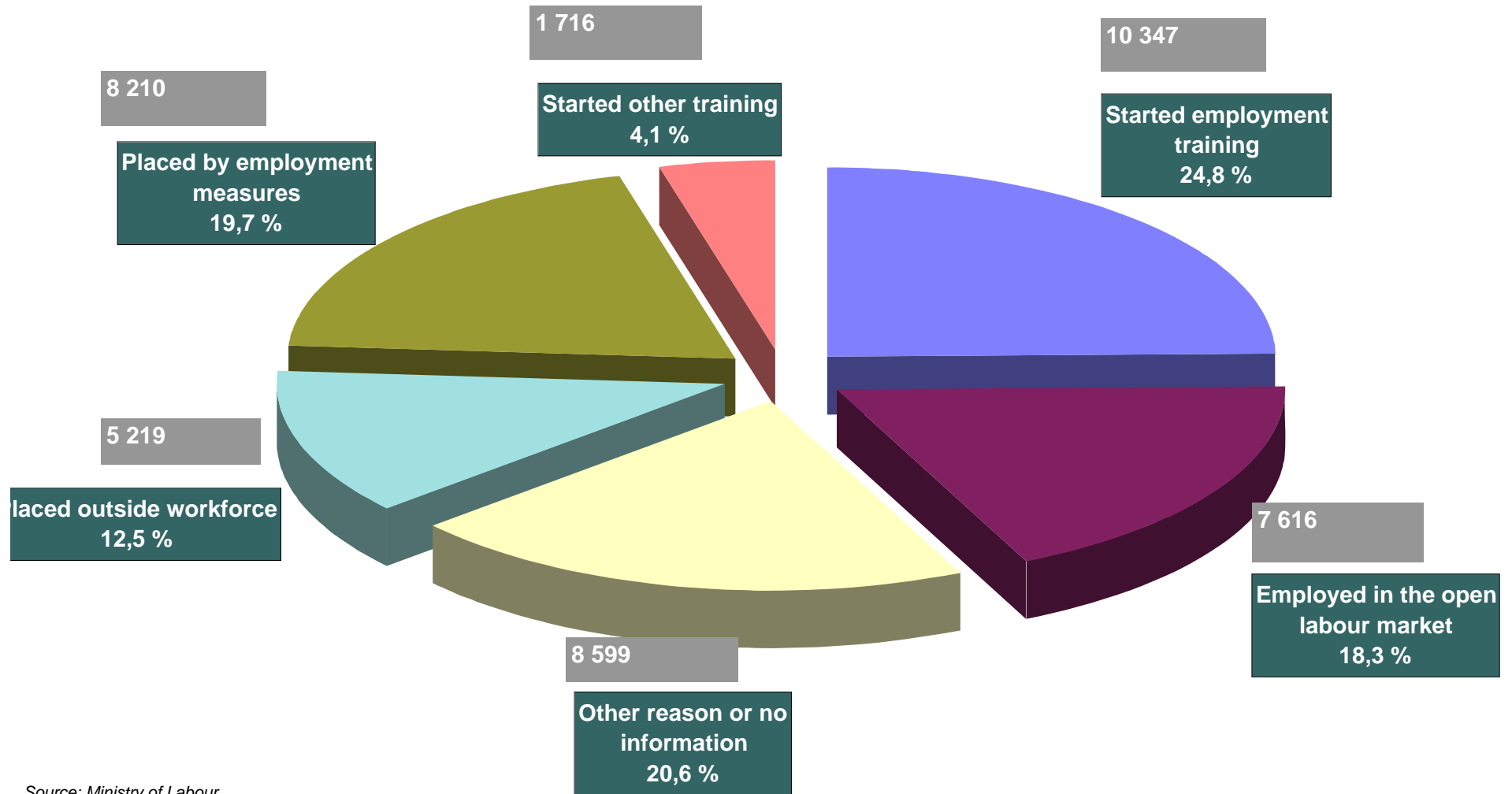
Individual integration plans of immigrant job seekers in 2006

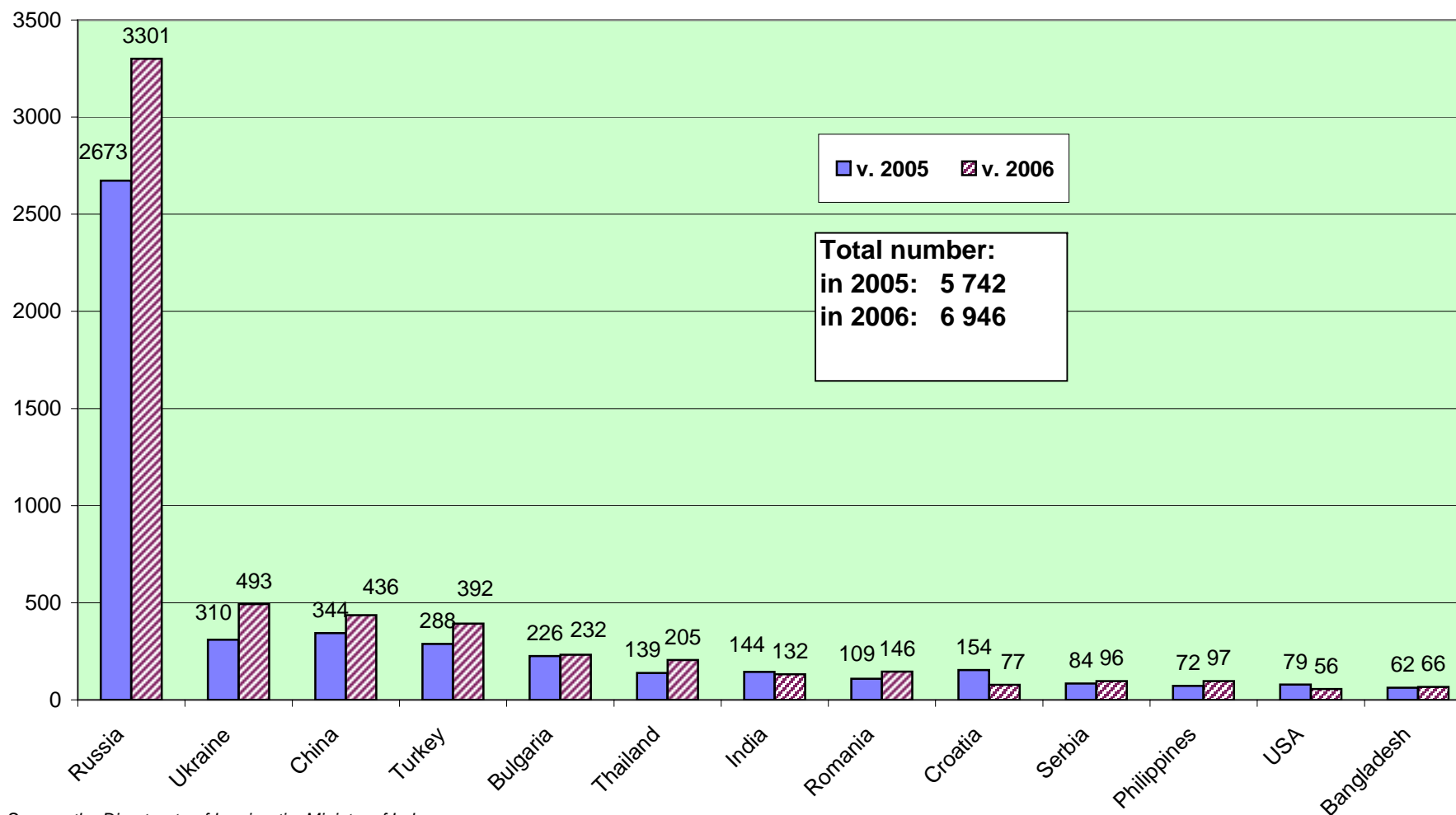
Immigrant job seekers with individual integration plans: Employment services and other measures in 2006

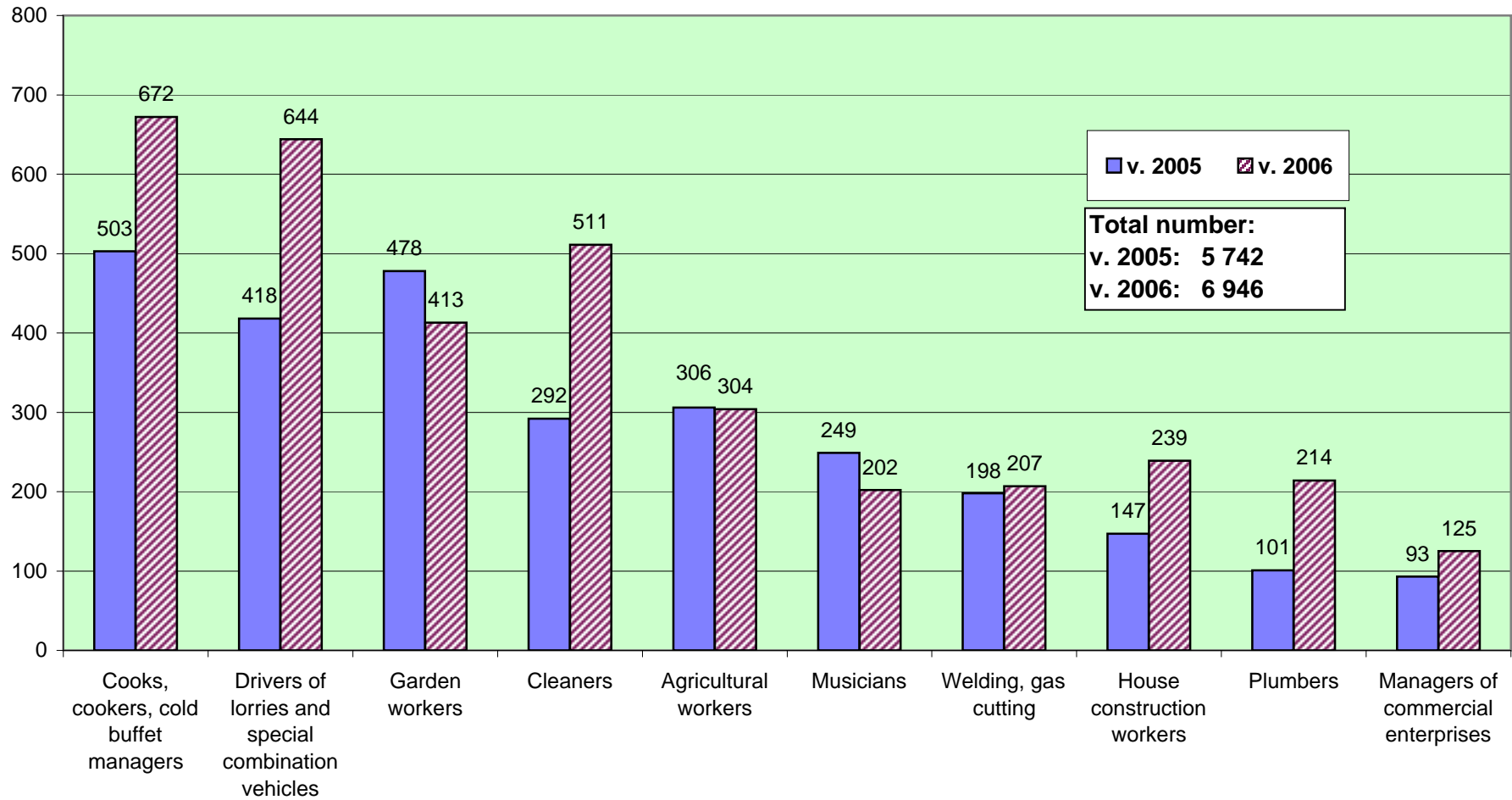

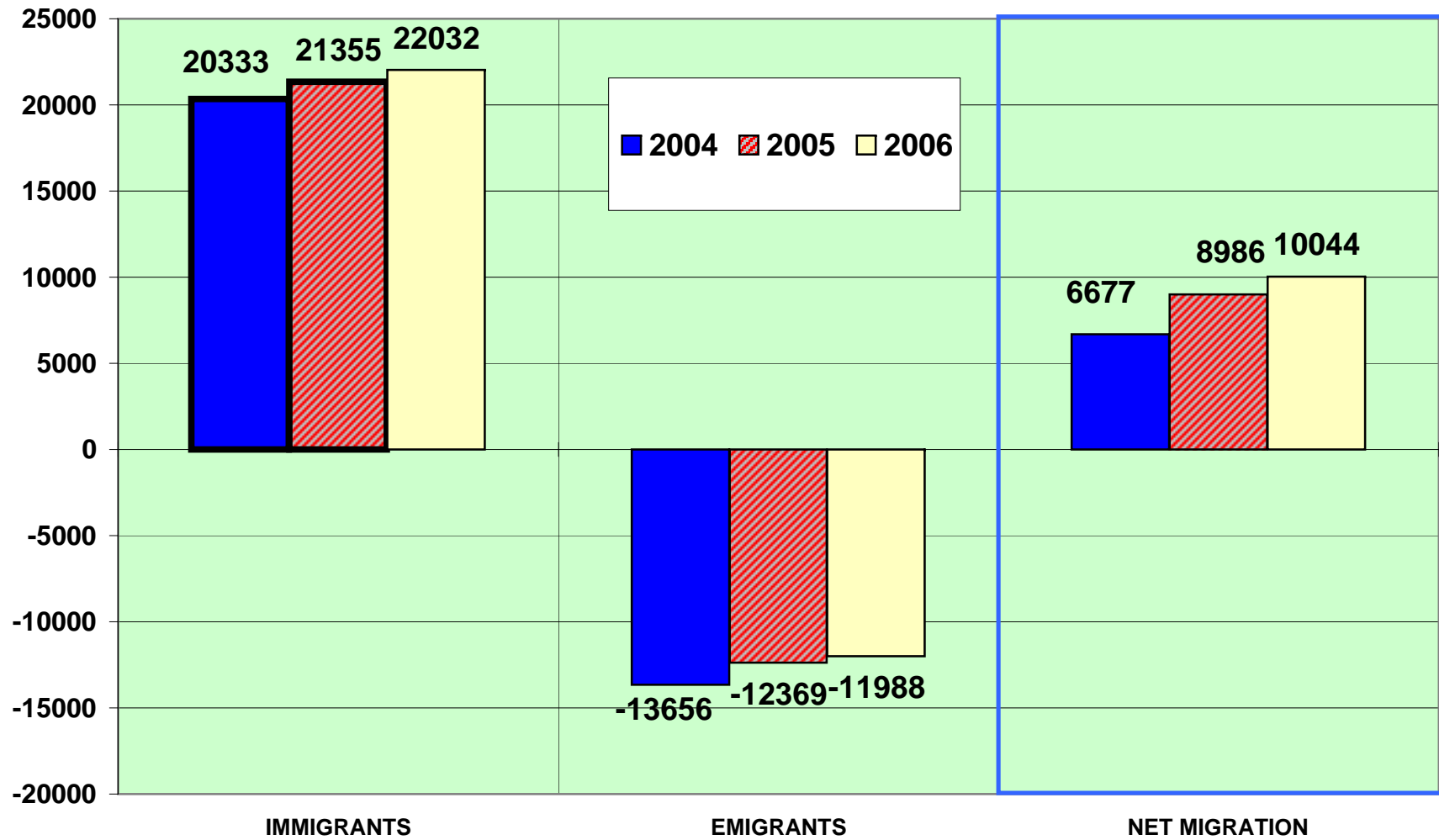

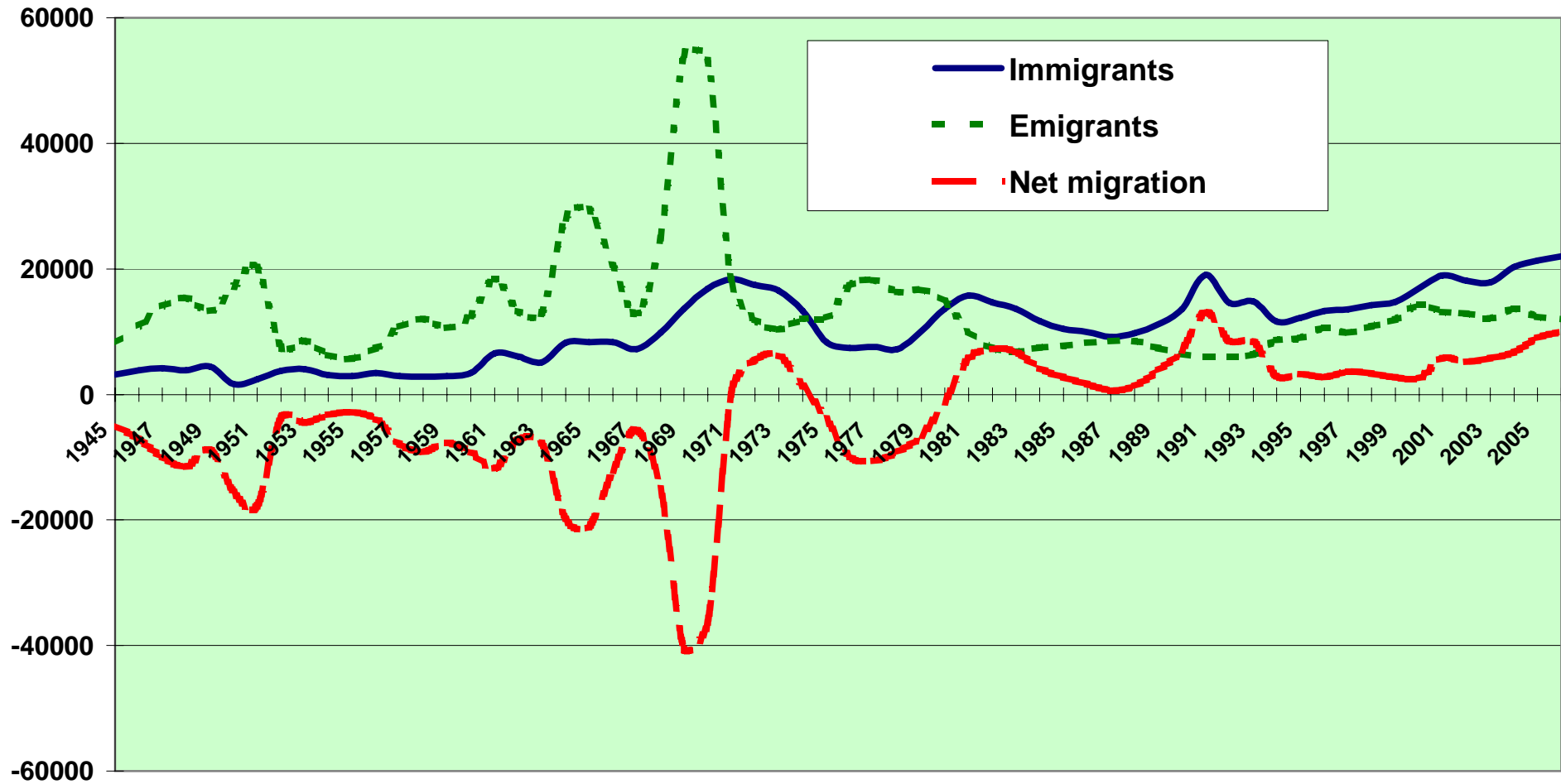
IMMIGRATION AND EMIGRATION IN 2004-2006
